The elections for the Supreme Elementary Learner Government (SELG) and Supreme Secondary Learner Government (SSLG) play a crucial role in cultivating leadership skills and empowering learners to actively engage in school governance. These election not only offer learners the chance to learner-led organizations in strengthening a dynamic and inclusive school environment.

2. As part of the preparations for School Year (S.Y.) 2025-2026, the SELG and SSLG elections will be conducted after the 3<sup>rd</sup> quarter examinations of S.Y. 2024-2025, adhering to the schedule outlined below:



**LEARNER GOVERNMENT ELECTIONS FOR  
 SCHOOL YEAR (SY) 2025-2026**

To: Schools Division Superintendents

1. Reference is made to the DepEd Order No. 47, s. 2024, titled "Constitution and By-Laws of the Supreme Pupil Government and Supreme Student Government in Elementary and Secondary Schools." The Department of Education recognizes the Learner Government Program (LGP) — formerly known as the Student Government Program (SGP) — as the primary co-curricular, learner-led organization responsible for implementing programs, projects, and activities in all schools nationwide.

2. The Supreme Elementary Learner Government (SELG) and Supreme Secondary Learner Government (SSLG) elections are critical in developing leadership skills among learners, empowering them to actively engage in school governance, and promoting a vibrant school culture. These elections offer learners the opportunity to assume leadership roles while fostering involvement in decision-making processes that contribute to holistic growth.

3. As part of the preparations for SY 2025-2026, the Department, through the Bureau of Learner Support Services (BLSS) and the Youth Formation Division (YFD), announces the schedule for the SELG and SSLG elections. These elections will be held following the 3rd quarter examination of SY 2024-2025 according to the following schedule:

- School-Based Elections: February 12-28, 2025
- Division Elections: March 3-14, 2025
- Regional Federation Elections: March 17-28, 2025
- National Federation Elections: To be announced in a separate memorandum

4. The objective of this initiative is to establish learner representation at all levels of governance, from the school to the national level, through the SELG and SSLG elections for SY 2025-2026.

5. To ensure the successful implementation of this program, all Schools Division Superintendents (SDSs), and School Heads, through their respective Youth Formation Coordinators (YFCs) and SELG/SSLG Advisers, are


