


Subject: **CONDUCT OF THE END OF SCHOOL YEAR (EOSY) RITES IN SDO
PANGASINAN II**

PARTICULARS

End of School Year (EOSY) Rites marks as milestone in the lives of the learners. In the conduct of said rites, this Office specifically reiterates the following existing policies and guidelines of the Department of Education for your reference:

1. Graduation and Moving Up Ceremonies shall be **simple but meaningful affair**, without excessive spending, extravagant attire, or extraordinary venue;
2. Expenses relative to these Rites **shall be charged to the School's Maintenance and Other Operating Expenses (MOOE)**;
3. Schools are directed to adhere to the **"NO COLLECTION POLICY"** as stated in **DepEd Order No. 19, Series of 2008**, otherwise known as **"Implementation of No Collection Policy in All Public Elementary and Secondary Schools"** and **DepEd Order No. 41, Series of 2024** or the **"Reiteration of the No Collection Policy in Schools"**.
4. Any donation or contribution from the PTA may be accepted provided they are on VOLUNTARY basis, through a Resolution made in a General PTA Meeting/Assembly. **NO TEACHER or SCHOOL PERSONNEL shall be involved in the collection and safekeeping of the amount contributed. It shall be managed by the PTA;**
5. The Graduation and Moving Up Ceremonies of Public Elementary and Secondary Schools scheduled on April 14 to 15, 2025 coincide with the Campaign Period for both the National and Local Candidates. Adherence to **DepEd Order No. 48, Series of 2018** on the Prohibition on Electioneering and Partisan Political Activity. Political neutrality shall be observed at all times, and everyone is enjoined to make a unified stand that the school are neutral zones.
